In addition to her profound professional achievements, Dr. Raana Akbar was a loving and supportive mother to two daughters, Amna and Zainab, and a son, Ahmed. Friends and colleagues agree that Dr. Raana Akbar was a genuinely kind and thoughtful friend and a warm and wonderful soul. She was highly respected throughout the physician community, and her contributions to the Saginaw area have been invaluable. She was a force for peace in our community, and her life and work was a blessing for us all.

- Provide proof of a grade point average of 2.5 or higher.
- Submit a written statement of not more than 500 words stating reasons for pursing the Dr. Raana Akbar Scholarship for Women in Health Care.
- Attach current letters of recommendation from any two (2) of the following: high school or college/university teacher(s), counselors, administrators, and/or community leaders.
- Submit a completed application with attachments by **April 18** for enrollment commencing in the fall session of the academic year.

Selection will be based on information contained in the application.

Incomplete or late applications will not be accepted.
